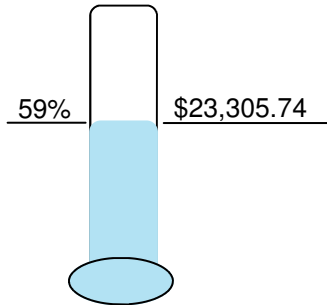

**Beatitude # 5 Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.**

November is the month of reflecting on what each of us is grateful for in our lives. It is a month when many of us have the opportunity to sit with relatives and friends and thank God for the time we spend together. Some of us travel great distances to be with family. Yet, others gather around the usual family dinner table and think about those who are unable to travel to join in the feast. Some families use the time together to speak of specific things, events, or situations as each gives thanks. Hopefully, everyone around the Thanksgiving table takes a moment to thank God for his graces; one being mercy.

The dictionary defines mercy as a loving disposition or temperament which transfers into showing love, compassion, and forgiveness to others. Many find love and compassion easier to give than forgiveness. This beatitude makes us realize that a true disciple of Jesus strives to be merciful in every way. God gives us some wonderful examples of being merciful. Through the parable about the prodigal son, we see a father forgive his wayward son. Jesus forgave Peter after he denied knowing him three times. How amazing Jesus was when he turned to the thief on the cross next to him and showed forgiveness. If we understand the meaning of mercy and show mercy to others, God promises, through this beatitude, that on judgment day, we will be rewarded because we showed we understood the meaning of mercy and treated others the way we wished to be treated.

This is the time of year we begin to think of others and give clothing, food, and shelter to those in need. We think about those unfortunate than us and open our hearts and wallets to help. These are physical acts of mercy and kindness that can be visibly seen, however, the spiritual works of mercy are just as important, but much harder to do. We must try to have patience with others, forgive those who injure others, help sinners find a path to God, counsel those who doubt, educate in God's name, and comfort those who in sorrow. As we are merciful to others, so our Heavenly Father will be merciful with us! Jesus reminds us that whatever "you did to the least of my brethren, you did it to me (Matthew 25:31-46)." As we live this valuable beatitude, we will be free of the coldness that could steal our Christian joy.
