**Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the office - 728-2228 or the Rectory - 335-2700.

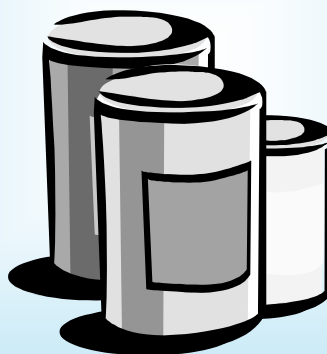
**New Parishioners:** Welcome to our parish. We would like to get to know you and invite you to register. Registration forms are available in the Parish office and in each of the Churches.

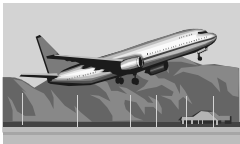
